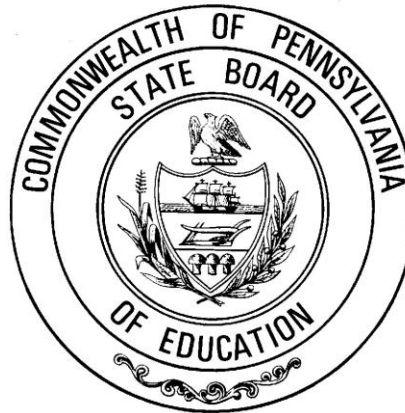

Authority

Article XXVI-B School Code

- Adopt regulations, standards & policies to govern education in Pennsylvania
- Master Plans for basic and higher education

Other Responsibilities

- Approve changes in school district boundaries (via Independent School Districts or voluntary mergers)
 - Riegelsville ISD
 - Porter Township ISD
 - Washington Township ISD
- Approve new community colleges or changes to sponsorship of current community colleges
 - Sunbury
- Award accreditation to postsecondary Career and Technical Education programs
 - Lehigh, York & Huntingdon applications in process

Other Responsibilities

- Approve authorized private school accreditors
 - Middle States & PA Assoc. of Independent Schools
 - AdvancED
 - The Educational Enrichment Initiative
- Conduct studies & make recommendations on educational policy (*State School Fund*)
 - School Library Study
 - Benefits and Detriments of Mandating Dating Violence Education

State Board Membership

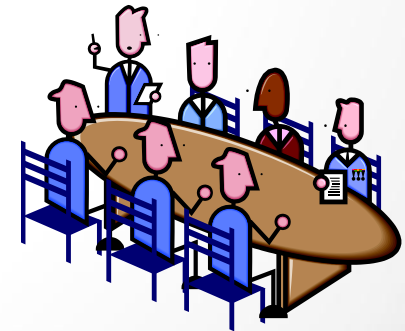
- 21 voting members
 - 17 nominated by Governor/confirmed by Senate to serve 6 year staggered terms
 - 4 Legislative members – chairs of Ed Cmtes.
- 4 Student members (2 H.S./2 postsecondary)
- Secretary of Education is Board CEO
- Professional Standards & Practices Commission Ex-officio member

State Board Structure

- Work conducted through standing and special ad hoc committees
- Council of Basic Education
- Council of Higher Education
- State Board for Vocational Education/State Board of Education
- State Board Chairman & Council Chairs selected by Governor

State Board Meetings

- Statutory requirement to convene at least 6 times per year
- 2-day* meetings held:
 - Jan., March, May, July, Sept. & Nov.
 - Wednesday-Thursday
- Meetings open to the public
- Public comment period
- Meeting schedule on web site



Regulatory Development/Approval

Three Stages to Process

- Board review & development
- Proposed stage
- Final stage

Regulatory Development/Approval

1st Stage

- Roundtable meetings or public hearings held to solicit stakeholder/public input
- Draft Regulation approved by State Board Standing Committee
- Draft Regulation forwarded to Council & Board; Board announces intention to adopt

Regulatory Development/Approval

2nd Stage - Proposed Stage

- Reviewed by Gov. Policy, Gov. Budget, Gov. General Counsel and Attorney General
- Submitted to House & Senate Education Committees, Independent Regulatory Review Commission (IRRC), PA Bulletin for comment
- Public must be provided 30-days to submit formal comments
- State Board considers comments and revises proposed regulation as appropriate

Regulatory Development/Approval

3rd Stage – Final-form Stage

- Board adopts final regulation
- Submits to Gov. Policy, Gov. Budget & Gov. General Counsel
- Submits for approval by House and Senate Education Committees & IRRC
- Submits to Attorney General for approval
- Published in Pennsylvania Bulletin

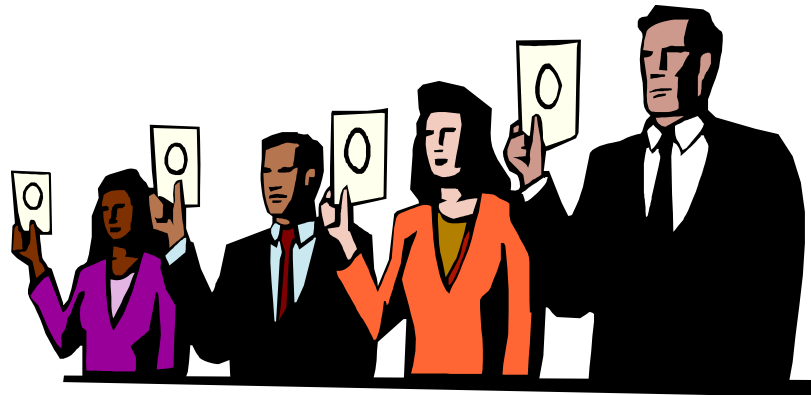

- College Textbook Policies Advisory Committee
- Annual report on certifications

Recent Statutes Impacting the Board

- Act 70 of 2014: Study on instruction in holocaust, genocide and human rights violations; potential to promulgate regulations
- Act 126 of 2014 (Rural Regional College): authority to promulgate regulations
- Act 82 of 2012
 - Educator Effectiveness: amendments to new evaluation forms must be made via regulatory review process
 - Performance measures for superintendents: authority to promulgate regulations
