Samantha Koch currently serves as Executive Policy Specialist at the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE). In that role, she researches, analyzes, and makes recommendations to state policymakers regarding a wide range of issues affecting the commonwealth's diverse learners.

Prior to her work at PDE, Samantha was Director of Strategic Initiatives at the Clery Center, a national nonprofit organization focused on improving student safety and well-being on college and university campuses. In that role, Samantha developed and led the organization's first membership program, the Collaborative, focused on institutionalizing compliance with the federal *Jeanne Clery Act*, and presented nationally on strategies to improve policy implementation efforts. Samantha also served as a Member Services and Outreach Associate at The Investment Fund for Foundations (TIFF), a cooperative-style investment firm serving endowed nonprofits, including educational institutions.
