

Elizabeth J. Wright, Ph.D.



Elizabeth Wright is Director of Academic Affairs at Penn State Hazleton, a position she has held since 2011. As DAA, she supervises 47 full- and 20 part-time faculty, as well as ten academic staff positions. In 2015-2016, she was a Department Executive Officer Fellow for the Committee on Institutional Cooperation, and in 2016, she received the Penn State Commission for Women Achieving Woman Award for the Administrator Category.

Prior to serving as DAA, she was a faculty member in English at Penn State Hazleton. She was an assistant professor of English from 2000 until 2009, when she was tenured and promoted to Associate Professor. During this time she taught courses in composition, United States literature, and Women's Literature. She received the Hazleton Educational Council Award for Teaching Excellence in 2006. She holds a Bachelor of Arts in English from the University of New Hampshire, a Masters of Arts in English Language and Literature from the University of New Mexico, and a Ph. D. in English Language and Literature from the University of New Mexico. She has published articles on childhood and war, economics and education, and portrayals of disability in Western American Literature.
