Since October 2015, Glenn Miller has served as the Deputy Secretary and Commissioner for Libraries in the Office of Commonwealth Libraries of the Pennsylvania Department of Education (after serving as Acting Deputy Secretary for three months). Prior to this role, Glenn served for 20 years as Executive Director of the Pennsylvania Library Association (PaLA). Prior to joining PaLA, Glenn spent more than two decades working in government and politics, and running his own writing, public relations, and association management business.
