Robert L. Fayfich serves as the Executive Director of Pennsylvania Coalition of Public Charter Schools. In addition, Bob is a Commissioner in the Middle States Commission on Secondary Schools.

Bob has an extensive entrepreneurial, corporate, and public service background. In 1996, he created a successful executive coaching business dedicated to working with senior executives in Fortune 100 corporations and non-profit organizations to change behaviors, enhance communication, and improve personal and organizational performance.

Prior to starting his own business, he spent twenty-two years at Westinghouse where he served as principal internal communication counsel to four CEOs; directed worldwide external and internal communications for a \$3 billion business; and planned and led internal communications efforts through twenty-six acquisitions and divestitures, four corporate restructurings and three CEO successions.

He is a member of the World Affairs Council and Leadership Pittsburgh and has taught or lectured at Carnegie Mellon University, the University of Pittsburgh, the University of St. Gallen in Switzerland, and in two Pittsburgh inner city schools.
